

Grace and Empathy – by Brady Horner

One of the qualities that should separate Christians from the rest of the world is our counterintuitive way of extending radical grace. By this I mean showing people an undeserved favor or giving people not what they "deserve," but something much better. Christianity is not a merit-based religion, we earn nothing but are given everything. From Christ's fullness "we have all received grace, upon grace." Consequently, because we have all received grace and need grace, we should freely extend it. Unfortunately, throughout our history we have struggled with receiving grace. We really want to feel like we have earned the blessings we receive. Because of this, and the hyper-individualistic culture we live in, we are often more inclined to give people what they deserve, make people "lie in the bed they have made", and rarely bless people unless they have "earned" it (or earned our sympathy).

Grace is beautiful and powerful, but so counterintuitive to our way of thinking that it's difficult to accept and harder to give. I'm not an expert at giving grace, and often don't; but I know that one of the keys to helping us extend grace to others is empathy. If we can put ourselves in someone else's shoes and understand where they are coming from, why they are doing the offensive things they are doing, it can be a little easier to let it slide. Something my mom used to say when I complained about grumpy church people was "they are trying to please God". She wasn't agreeing with them, but she was pointing out that they aren't trying to be fun killers, they are doing what they believe God wants. It's really an empathetic statement, and it is a little more difficult to be mad at people who are trying to do the right thing. I know this does not help in every situation (because people do not always mean well), but since I learned this, I have found it much easier to extend grace for offenses that are done with good intentions.
