




Summer Family Fun Nights

From the Internet to the Real World – by Brady Horner

Everyone knows I'm not a big fan of phones and social media, but I've really been trying to rein that in. Not because I'm changing my mind, I just don't want people to get annoyed and guit listening to me. But I just can't help myself. I have seen a lot of toxic phone, social media, and internet behavior spill over into real world interactions. This technology allows us to block, ghost, and ignore people that bother us online. This power has caused many to X people out of their lives. Not only is this happening more often, but people are being applauded for it!

Rather than communicating to someone how they hurt us, we simply avoid them (ghosting). Instead of working through disputes, we drop the relationship (blocking). We don't do the difficult and awkward parts of normal human interaction online (or when we do, it is in an extremely unhealthy manner), and now we don't do it in the real world. We are losing our ability to resolve relationship issues. Surely the divorce rate is going to get even worse! Additionally, this is contributing to our inability to problem solve. Rather than work through and face problems, we block and ignore them.

Equally disturbing is that we are taught human relationships are disposable. As soon as you don't like what a person says, does, or believes, you can drop them like they aren't anything. We learn to treat people, not as humans created in God's image with a complicated story, deep needs, and intricate feelings, but as symbols on a screen that we can swipe out of our lives. We treat institutions similarly. We are quick to leave churches when they do something we don't like, quit patronizing businesses after one bad experience, and quit jobs after leadership makes a few frustrating changes. Multiple times Christ said that if you have an issue with a brother go to them, be reconciled to them. He calls us to be people of commitment and reconciliation. Let's not allow technology and culture to change who Jesus calls us to be.


