### Uber Car Confessions: The "Indian" Call Center Guy by Brady Horner

In Sydney we had an Uber driver from Pakistan take us on what I thought would be an unpleasant ride. When we got in, he had a call on speaker, and we sat there in awkward silence listening to his conversation with someone in Urdu. Once off the phone we had such a nice visit that I almost thought about asking him if he wanted to hang out later! Turns out his call was a friend from Pakistan asking him for money. Like many other Uber driver immigrants in Australia, his money was being sent back home to take care of family and friends. He thought Australians were lazy! He said they put in minimal work hours and want to play all the time. He worked all the time, and never had extra money for luxuries. My guess is a lot of immigrants could say that about us here. While not all of us have everything handed to us, most had some kind of grounding that made our start at work life easier, and we typically only have ourselves to take care of. I can understand how challenging it would be for an immigrant to come to a new foreign country and start from scratch while also having to send money home.

As I visited with him and decided I liked him, I was very amused when he told me he used to work for a call center in Pakistan! He was that annoying "Indian" person that we always get frustrated with when we have a tech issue! He said they were not even really part of the company that you are calling. He felt they were hired to take verbal abuse from angry customers. During breaks the employees all get together to laugh and compare horrible things said to them! I'm glad they laughed it off because it convicted me. When I had to make those calls, I would quickly get impatient and rude to these people I deemed unhelpful (admittedly there were, it was clear there is little knowledge or training given). However, seeing the guy at the other end of the phone reminded me that they are real people with lives, families, emotions, and might even be likable! My new friend gave me a lot of empathy for a demographic different from me, but also much more alike than I thought. Perhaps I should lean more heavily into the wisdom of Proverbs 18: 2, "Fools have no interest in understanding, they only want to air their own opinion." When I stop jumping to my own conclusions and just listen, I can really gain an understanding of people that builds friendship rather than walls.
