


Ladies Bible Class Resumes This Month

My first Uber ride in Sydney was with a guy who was just ridiculously friendly. He wanted to tell us all about the city, and even took us a longer route to give a better view of Sydney Harbor. By this time, I had interacted with several Aussies and began to wonder, how do you make a culture so friendly? I sat by the coolest guy ever on the plane who wanted to give me all kinds of advice, wanted to know all about my trip, and wanted to know about me. I just kept thinking why are these people so nice? There seems to be no angle, nothing in it for them; they aren't trying to get a tip or manipulate me.

Obviously, not every Aussie is friendly (we had a few run-ins with the opposite), but there is a general culture of friendliness and hospitality. I'm not sure if the chicken or the egg came first, but the friendly culture is associated with the common title of endearment "mate". They use it like Americans use "man", but it has a friendlier connotation. It's as if we are all automatically "mates" or partners or friends. That is a different attitude than in the more individualistic U.S. where we are not default friends. We don't know each other, you might be a political opponent, or an obstacle to me getting out of the grocery store in time! Our society is much more competitive than cooperative. I love that attitude of "we are all mates". I think it's not only good for a nation, but it's something the church should mimic as well. I suppose at one point, Christians modeled it first, but we have generally lost that attitude.

Another reason I think Aussies are friendly is their sense of curiosity. The friendliest people were curious about my accent, what we were doing on our trip, and what our lives were like in the U.S. They didn't have a judgmental fear of foreigners coming in and messing things up. They welcomed us as having new insights, and interesting ideas to offer (although they did seem to have an unfair prejudice that Americans are dumb). It is curiosity that makes us ask about people and want to know them. When we desire to know people, we show that we care about who they are, and this creates a sense of warmth and hospitality. May the Church not be fearful of those who are different but have a sense of curiosity that welcomes them with hospitality.
