Sermon Title: Cain

Scripture: Genesis 4: 3-8

In the course of time Cain brought some of the fruits of the soil as an offering to the Lord. And Abel also brought an offering—fat portions from some of the firstborn of his flock. The Lord looked with favor on Abel and his offering, but on Cain and his offering he did not look with favor. So Cain was very angry, and his face was downcast.

Then the Lord said to Cain, “Why are you angry? Why is your face downcast? If you do what is right, will you not be accepted? But if you do not do what is right, sin is crouching at your door; it desires to have you, but you must rule over it.”

Now Cain said to his brother Abel, “Let’s go out to the field.” While they were in the field, Cain attacked his brother Abel and killed him.

Children’s Ministry News

This morning, our lesson comes from Psalm 23:5-6 and Ruth 2-4.

In this passage, at the end of his song about how God is like our shepherd, David celebrates God’s blessings in his life, proclaiming that his cup overflows with blessings. Those blessings include God’s goodness and unfailing love pursuing him. For Ruth, God’s blessings include food and family.

These last verses provide us with an opportunity to talk about blessings with our children. We need to be mindful of our children’s perception of what blessings are and clarify any misunderstandings since the definition of blessing may be different for them, depending on factors beyond their control. Even though blessings can be different for everyone, our Bible point this week reminds us that **God blesses us**.

With everything going on in and around our world, our children are becoming more aware of their surroundings and environment, which could lead to some stress and anxiety that can feel like the “dark valleys.”

Let us remember to keep our children in prayer as well as our parents and teachers so that God, our comforter, will strengthen them with wisdom and guidance.

Summary Verse: “The Lord is my shepherd; I have all that I need” (Psalm 23:1). Don’t forget to keep practicing your memory verse and the rest of Psalm 23.
