“Invalid” Baptism 2—by Brady Horner

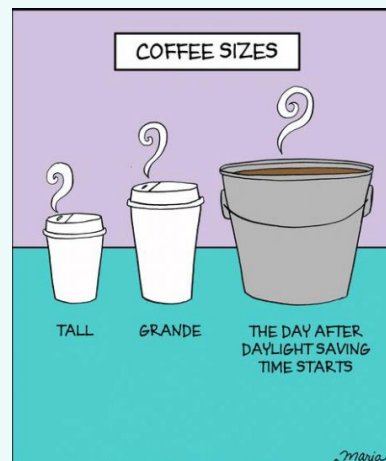
The Catholic Church’s debacle over invalid baptisms due to priests saying “we baptize you” rather than “I baptize you” has made me think more about the words spoken at baptism. How important are they? Is there a specific formula that must be said? Could any “wrong” words invalidate a baptism?

The most universal baptismal statement used across many denominations is based on the Great Commission “I baptize you in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit”. This is used from the Catholic Church to the Churches of Christ. The Orthodox Church uses the statement “this person is baptized...” which avoids the “I” versus “we” issue currently taking place in the Catholic Church. I like this approach because it takes the act of the one baptizing out of the picture; neither the priest nor the Church bestow the grace/gifts of baptism, God does. The widely used universal statement above is interestingly not used in the book of Acts! In Acts they only baptized into the name of Christ! Some Christian groups today would invalidate a baptism that neglected the name of the Father and Holy Spirit! Do we really have the gall to say that a baptism in Acts is invalid!? Perhaps we shouldn’t be splitting hairs over the wording.

The Churches of Christ have no written baptismal liturgy we are to speak...but there is an assumed one. After performing my first baptism at a Church, I failed to speak the full unspoken Church of Christ liturgy. I was (kindly) called out for it! I spoke the full universal statement, “I baptize you in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit” but failed to add (the Churches of Christ Acts 2:38 addition) “for the remission of your sins.” They didn’t make me redo the baptism, but that additional doctrinal statement is important to us and differentiates our views on baptism from other groups. So, perhaps the baptismal wording is more a reminder for us than God. That said, I love the baptismal wording that the Baptists adapt from Romans 6:4. As the person is dunked the baptizer speaks “buried with Jesus by baptism into death” then as they bring them up “raised to walk in newness of life”. The wording is important because it describes what is taking place and is a powerful message. However, the power of baptism is in God’s grace, not our words, and I do not believe that our “wrong” words can invalidate God’s grace.
