his love toward Israel endures forever.”

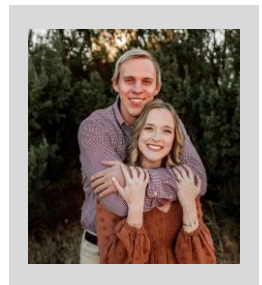
