#### The Gratitude Gender Gap – by Brady Horner

I've been thinking and praying a lot about this *Overflow* series and the transformative power of living and receiving life as a gift with gratitude. In the back of my mind, I've had this strange prejudice that it might be too "girly" and that men might check out. I realize that I've subliminally thought that women emphasize and express gratitude much more than men. What a weird thing to think!? However, I've done some research and it looks like it is true; women are generally more grateful than men, or they at least show it more.

A 2012 survey of 2000 Americans found that "Women are more likely than men to express gratitude on a regular basis (52 percent women/44 percent men), feel that they have much in life to be thankful for (64 percent women/50 percent of men), and express gratitude to a wider variety of people." A separate study found that women post much more often about gratitude on social media than men. While there is definitely a gender issue, one study found that it is an American issue as well. Here it was discovered that German men generally view gratitude as a higher virtue than American men.

My guess is that in America, men are expected to be strong, autonomous, and fully self-sufficient (going back to the Manifest Destiny pioneer days). Thus gratitude, that admits someone helped me, or part of my success was given, not earned, sounds like weakness. For some, gratitude may reflect dependency and weakness. Let's be honest, there is a pride in us that keeps us from experiencing gratitude (something men may be more susceptible to, but women aren't completely above). Admittedly, the gratitude could be present, but not expressed; men aren't known for being great at expressing feelings. So this points us to two things we must do in our journey toward becoming people overflowing with gratitude. One, we must humble ourselves and admit we need and require help, we are not completely self-made, much of what we have was received, not earned. Second, we must learn to not simply feel gratitude, but express it in meaningful ways.
