
All-Church Retreat

David said to Michal, "It was before the Lord, who chose me rather than your father or anyone from his house when he appointed me ruler over the Lord's people Israel—I will celebrate before the Lord. I will become even more undignified than this, and I will be humiliated in my own eyes. But by these slave girls you spoke of, I will be held in honor."

And Michal daughter of Saul had no children to the day of her death.

When driving east on Ambler towards I-20, use the turn-in on the right just before the light at Ambler and Judge Ely. Continue driving south through the parking lot past the ACU Football Stadium and University Park apartments until you see the entrance to the Hunter Welcome Center parking lot on your left, before you enter the roundabout. There is a covered overhang on the left/north side of the building (from the entrance) that is probably easiest to use to drop people off.
