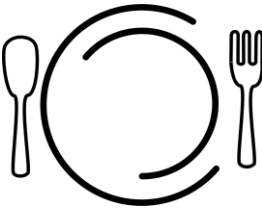
Love Grub Wednesday Night

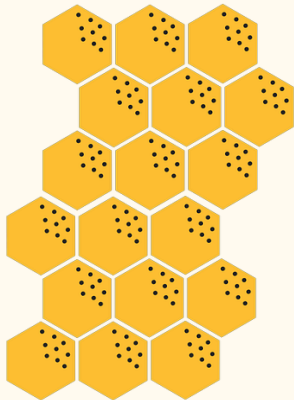

Scripture: Proverbs 16: 21-28
